The clinics of the Social Welfare Board continue to provide much needed services to the uninsured residents of Buchanan County, living with annual incomes of \$23,540.00 or less. Even with the options available through the Affordable Care Act, 14% of Buchanan County residents ages 18-64 years, do not have health insurance. This translates to approximately 12,000 of our neighbors and friends are uninsured with limited funds.
