On the Beat...

The clinic's 2017-2018 fiscal year concluded on June 30th with the following accomplishments:

- ◆ Provided 13,746 medical and women's health visits;
- ◆ Provided 3,043 dental visits and 925 hygiene visits;
- ◆ Concluded year 3 for the HEALTH program, a collaboration with 26 community organizations that provides a framework to reduce the barriers that keep folks in a persistent state of poverty;
- ◆ Began year one of the third cycle of being a recognized patient centered medical home through NCQA;
- ◆ Continue to partner with MOSAIC's Advocacy Program to house a patient advocate at the clinic to process necessary financial information;
- ◆ Completed year 3 of the Family Planning contract;
- ◆ After managing the HOME Unit, a wrap-around program for the Homeless, moved it to Northwest Health;
- ◆ Completed the 2nd year of LifeChangers, a monthly engaged giving program through the Friends of the Free Clinic.
