The Social Welfare Board continues to fill a unique niche. We are 1 of 12 free and charitable clinics in Missouri. Over half of the agency's patients are employed, but still do not earn enough money to provide for their basic needs such as health care. Furthermore, most of the clinics patients do not qualify for Medicaid insurance because they make more than \$185.00 a month and don't have a disability, nor can they afford health insurance or pay out of pocket for health care. We are grateful to be able to help our neighbors in need be the healthiest version of themselves.
