The Clinic has 203 patients enrolled in its new Diabetic Care Coordination program, funded by Americares, Baxter International and the Friends of the Free Clinic. Additionally, through this grant, funding is also provided for patients who meet pre-diabetic /diabetic criteria. Those patients receive proactive educational text messages through Care Signal.

The Social Welfare Board has been selected to assist with the CDC's vaccine hesitancy initiative, a partnership through Americares and Sostento.

Patients now have the option to access their medical record through the clinic's patient portal.

On June 23, 2021 the clinic is hosting an EMPLOYEE APPRECIATION breakfast!

The SWB's *Westside Clinic* is celebrating its 6th year as a Title X funded clinic. Westside is one of three clinics within the Social Welfare Board that provides reproductive health services, early detection cancer screenings for breast, cervical and testicular cancer, as well as important STD screenings. Because of the many programs Westside is able to leverage, numerous payer sources are accepted. Cost of services are waived for people with earnings below 100% of the poverty level. The SWB's Westside clinic is also a Show Me Healthy Woman provider which means if a person is enrolled in this program before a cancer diagnosis is made, the cost of their cancer treatment is paid.
