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On July 1, 2022 the Social Welfare Board's medical and Westside –women's health clinic went live with Athena One, an electronic medical record . The staff and volunteers have done very well learning how to navigate this new system. Latha Varghese, FNP and Jeanie Hambrick , Office manager have led much of the onboarding and training. In order to help staff learn and become comfortable with Athena One our patient schedules were reduced to half for two weeks.

Athena One will connect to Mosaic's EMR through an exchange program called CommonWell., enhancing patient record sharing on a need to know basis.

In July the Social Welfare Board brought on another Nurse Practitioner, Danyelle Kerns, She will split her time between medical and Westside Clinics. This is Danyelle's second time working for the SWB. Welcome back Danyelle!!!
