July 2022 the Social Welfare Board, in partnership with Youth Alliance and grant funding through the State of Missouri, HEALTH 2.0 was launched. (Helping Everyone Achieve Long Term Health) HEALTH is our new community health worker (CHW) program that employs lay people to work with our patients to assist them with needs related to the social determinants of health.

Goal To help the patients of the Social Welfare Board live a healthier life by optimizing and coordinating services to decrease the barriers that keep them in a state of poverty.

SCOPE of Service: The CHW is a person the provider team can call upon to assist patients with issues pertaining to housing, transportation, employment, community services, obtaining birth certificates/ID, food insecurity, etc.

CHW assessment process: The CHW will complete an assessment with the patient and scan the results to the SWB's EMR Find-Help. CHW and patient will discuss and create short and long-term goals. CHW will document all activity in agency's EMR. CHW's will make applicable social service referrals through Find Help – a bidirectional referral platform purchased by Mosaic for the use of the Community Network.

Ongoing care: Patients will remain under the care of the CHW until the patient's goals have been met and the patient no longer desires services and or CHW case maintenance. Soon a third CHW will be added to the HEALTH team.
